## Frog Patrol

- Designed for youth ages 5– 7 with parents as leaders at camp
- The youth's days are filled with tones of Crafts, many games and activities
- Gives staff members a chance to teach the other youth while their children are occupied



## Tenderfoot

- Designed for 3rd and 4th year cubs
- Runs Tuesday to Sunday
- The cubs get an introduction to the scout and Campanoe Challenge program.
- Crafts, lashing, hiking, canoeing, camp-craft and sport activities.

## First Year



- For 1st year Scouts and older those who have not attended before.
- Learn basic canoe and paddling strokes
- Learn lightweight backpacking and sleep in a unique shelter.
- Learn lashing to construct secret weapon for water fight
- Enjoy pizza and cookies cooked in a tin foil oven

## Second Year



- Builds on first year skills
- Starts out at Kamsack
- Travel down the Assiniboine River to Pyotts Point Manitoba
- Hone canoeing skills for 3rd year.

## Cub Program

- Program designed for 1st and 2nd year cubs.
- Runs Saturday to Wednesday
- Emphasis of the program is on recycling and disaster preparedness.
- All programming is taken from the Cub Book, meaning that throughout the week youth will work on badge requirements and on various camping skills.
- This program will be a lead up to the Tenderfoot Program which is designed for 3rd year Cubs.
